Notice no. 26 (2018)

On 12 March 2013, the Ministry of Commerce published the Notice No 16 of the year, decided to impose anti-dumping measures on import of Toluene Diisocyanate originating from the EU from 13 March 2013, for 5 years.

On 7 September 2017, the Ministry of Commerce published Notice No 49 and announced that the above measures would expire on 12 March 2018. Natural persons, legal persons and organisations representing domestic industry could submit application in written within 60 days to Mofcom to request an expiry review.

In the time, the Ministry of Commerce did not receive qualified applications, and the Ministry of Commerce decided not to initiate an expiry review. In this respect, the anti-dumping measures on Toluene Diisocyanate originating from the EU will be terminated from 13 March 2018.
