On the other hand, a substance will be removed when it is withdrawn in the European Union. The following amendment of the OPPh includes the removal of six chemical substances (Dodemorph, Fenpyrazamin, Flufenacet, Meptyldinocap, Metribuzin and Tritosulfuron).
